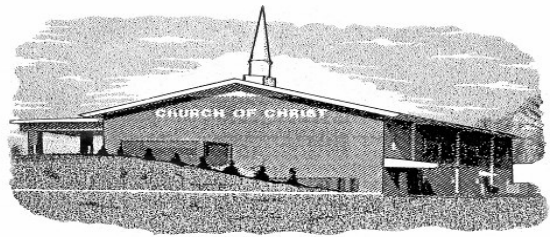
January 7th—Spring Meadows Area Wide
