**WEEKLY WORDS**

Each day should be a reminder to us of the importance of the event known as the resurrection. Is it ok to put a special significance on it Easter Sunday? Sure, and we usually include something about that as preachers since that is on people's minds. But let's never forget how crucial it is to us each day.
