### Easter Sunday

For many people, this particular Sunday has special significance. It's the day that is set aside to celebrate the resurrection day of our Savior. The fact that our Lord came forth from that tomb and that death couldn't hold Him is indeed a remarkable thing. While we might make this more of a focal point on this coming Sunday, let me give you something else to think about.

Technically this should be on our minds every day of the week, for the resurrection of Christ is of the utmost significance for our Christian life. Jesus was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we should walk a new life each and every day (Rom. 6:4). Those of us who have been raised up with Christ are to seek the things above where Christ is at the right hand of God (Col. 3:1). With Christ's resurrection being linked to our victory over death, we also look forward to our own resurrection as we work for the Lord (1 Cor. 15:57-58).

Every day that we are alive is a chance for us to live our own resurrected life as one who was brought back from the dead, as God made us alive with Christ and raised us up with Him and seated us in the heavenly places (Eph. 2:1-6). Each day should be a reminder to us of the importance of the event known as the resurrection. Is it ok to put a special significance on it Easter Sunday? Sure, and we usually include something about that as preachers since that is on people's minds. But let's never forget how crucial it is to us each day.

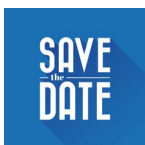

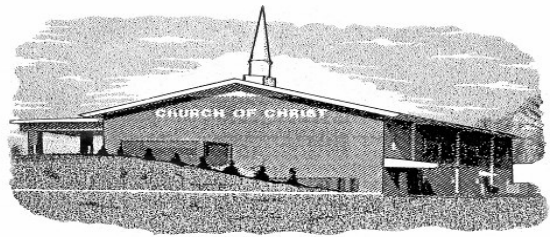
